Employment Opportunities Available

Don't forget to re-new your Pool and/or Tennis membership if it has expired. A permit is required to participate in many of the aquatic programs offered. Tennis permit holders are eligible for a discounted fee on most tennis programs. If you are planning to register online for any of our tennis programs you MUST renew your tennis permit prior to your online registration or you will not be eligible to receive the discounted fee for your tennis program. Memorial Park Tennis Courts are now open. Attendants will be on duty as of May 1st.

As a reminder, registration for all programs including camp and individual tennis lessons can now be done online. Pool Permit Renewals can also be done online this year. Mail in registrations or permit renewals must be paid by check or money order.
