

Westchester Power Update: Last year the Town Board and 20 other communities in Westchester County entered into an agreement with Sustainable Westchester to provide energy to residents. This is the first of its kind in New York State. Sustainable Westchester entered into a two year contract to supply 90,000 homes and businesses with electricity at fixed rates. Rates cannot increase during the two years of the contract. The good news: Everyone in the Town of Mamaroneck who is part of the agreement (those that did not opt out) enjoyed a modest savings during the past year. Please see the graph below. If Con Ed rates had gone up significantly during the past year, the savings to you would have been much greater.
